Logis-Tech Tokyo 2024 is **the best platform for those who seek productive meetings, new business, and finding solutions**.

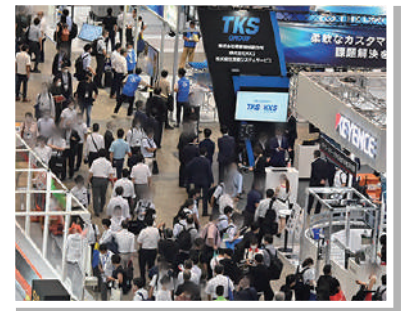

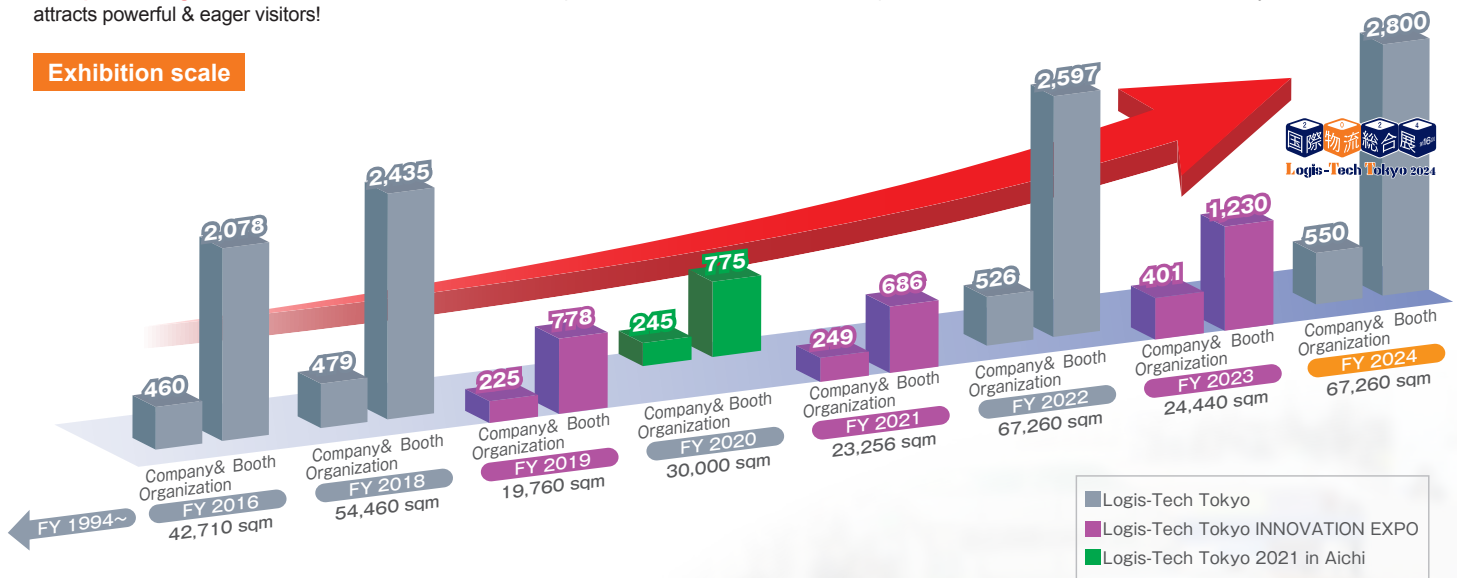

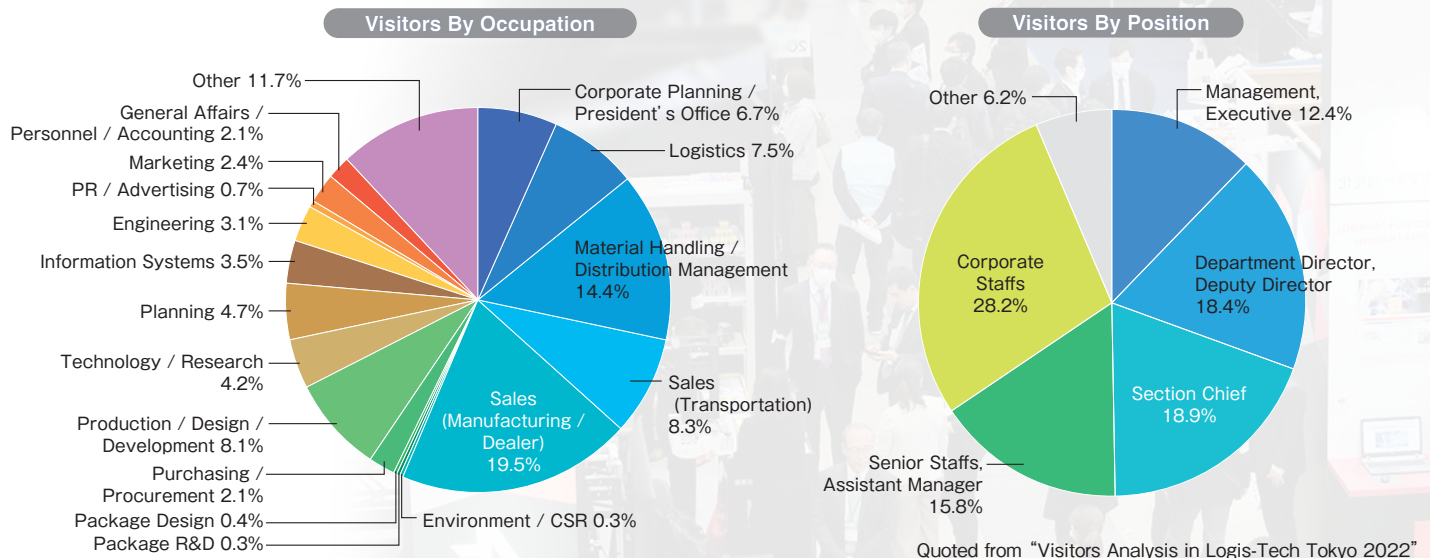
Exhibition scale

● In case the application fee is not remitted by due date, application will be cancelled.



Payment Method

Bank Transfer in JAPANESE YEN ONLY

Invoices are issued upon receipt of formal application. Please make bank transfers according to the invoices. Please be aware that failure to make payment by the payment deadline will result in cancellation. Japanese Yen is used for all payments. *Bank transfer fee shall be covered by the applicant.



Booth Layout

The organizers alone shall determine booth layout taking into account previous results (such as number of times of participation in the organizer's exhibition), number of booths, items to be exhibited, demonstrations, and order in which application is received.



Cancellation by Exhibitor

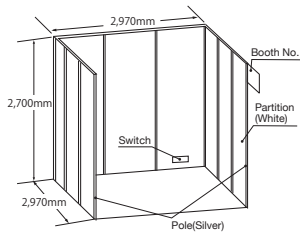

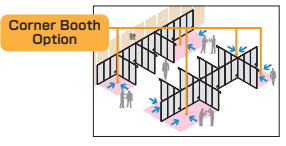

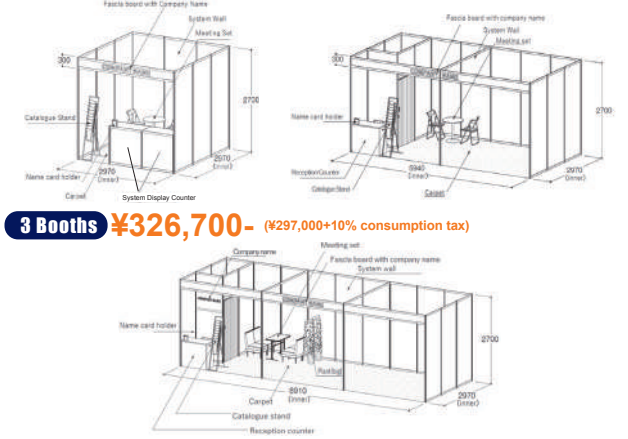
